



IMMERSION SUIT PS2006 - Complies with IMO Res. MSC. 207(81)

Instructions for Use:

1. Remove hood and footwear

2. Put on the suit - legs first

3. a: Tighten the cuff straps
b: Tighten the foot straps
c: Put on the hood
Zip the front zip fastener
Close the strap

4. Close the lifting strap

5. The emergency light is water activated. It can be activated/deactivated manually by pressing the switch

AFTER USE

1. Rinse the suit in fresh water on the outside.
2. Let suit dry on a wide hanger and air it.
3. When the suit is thoroughly dry pack it or keep it on a wide hanger.
4. Wax the front zip fastener with the wax stick supplied.

PACKING THE SUIT

1. Place the suit flat on the floor. Unzip.
- 2a. Fold up the feet and legs to the sleeves. Fold the hood down.
- 2b. Put the sleeves across the hood.
- 2c. Fold up the suit.
3. Put the suit into the bag.

MAINTENANCE

Examine the suit once a month. Put it on. Wax the front zip fastener with the wax stick.

SERVICE

We recommend that you hand it in for service every third year at a VIKING approved service station.

SPECIAL CONDITIONS

If you work on board rubber boats with non-skid floor boards, wear and tear may occur. Therefore check your suit carefully after use and if necessary hand it in for inspection at a VIKING approved service station.

Store the suit in a dark, cold and dry place - in temperatures not lower than zero degrees Celcius. Before packing the suit, see that the light is not switched on unintentionally and make sure that the suit is not squeezed.
